RE: R&O 2026-029 TITLE VI Policy review/update

Introduction: Linn County is required to review and update their Transportation Title VI (Civil Rights) program every 3 years, English and Spanish. The program was last revised in 2023. An ODOT Compliance review is scheduled for Linn County's Transportation Program in March or April 2026; updating the Transportation TITLE VI program will ensure maintaining compliance for the Civil Rights portion.

Upon review of the existing Transportation TITLE VI program, the document continues to meet all required language and processes. For the 2026 updates, few changes have been made where applicable:

- Updated the Linn County Transportation Advisory Committee roster
- Updated Linn County Demographic Data in the Four Factor Analysis
- Included updated information where Seamless Transit partnerships with OCWCOG are referenced in the document

Prior to this request, the 2026 updated document was reviewed by ODOT/PTD Civil Rights Department and found to include all required components and meet all compliance standards. The final steps are to have the governing body for Linn County adopt the program and update all existing postings with the new version.

Recommendation:

It is respectfully requested that the Board of Commissioners for Linn County adopt the 2026 TITLE VI (Civil Rights) program, English and Spanish versions, reflecting the updated information outlined above.

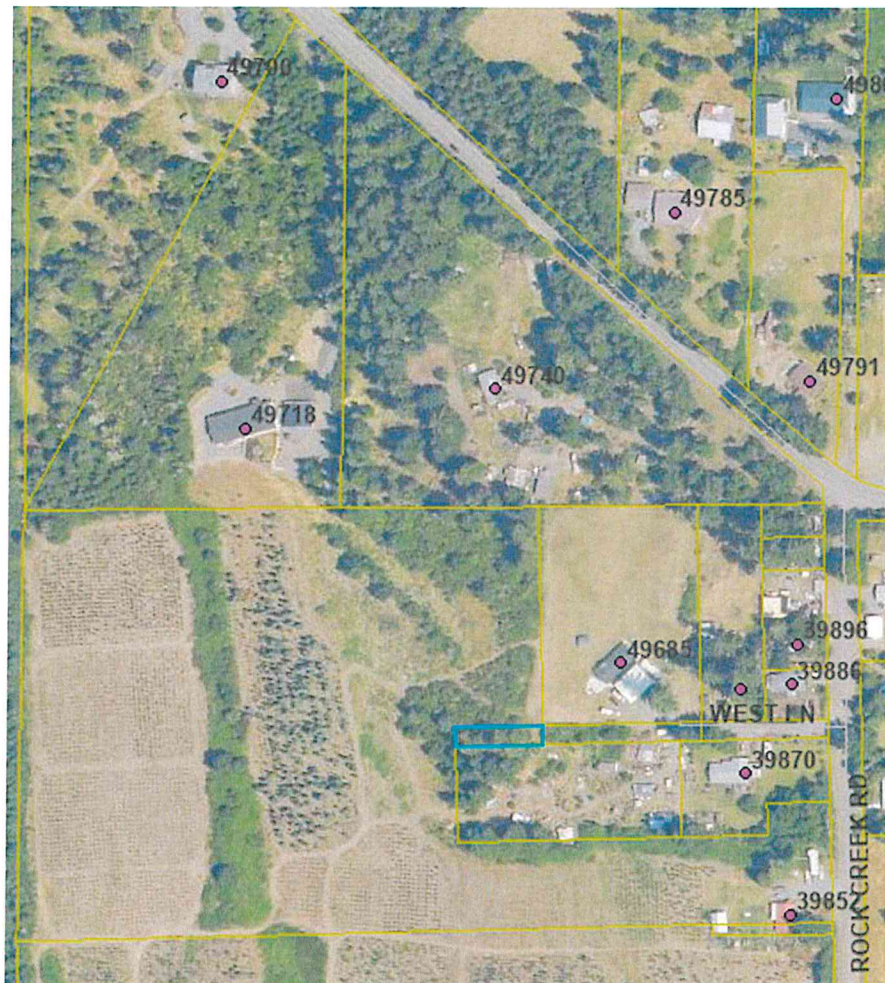
