The following item is scheduled to be heard on 12/19/2023:

Resolution & Order 2023-422: The Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) has historically funded the Emergency Management Program at the Linn County Sheriff's Office. The grant is through FEMA, and the funding is awarded through the Oregon Department of Emergency Management. This grant program is renewed once each year and requires the board of commissioner's signature. The funding period started on July 1, 2023, and ends on June 30, 2024.

Financial Impact: The EMPG funds approximately 50% of the staff costs for emergency management personnel at the Sheriff's Office.

Resolution & Order 2023-426: The following IGA is with the Oregon Department for Emergency Management. Per ORS 404.110, the Sheriff's Office is responsible for Search and Rescue operations in Linn County. Occasionally, these operations require the use of aircraft. This agreement outlines that if the County utilizes any aircraft, it can seek fuel and oil cost reimbursements through the Oregon Department of Emergency Management.

Financial Impact: Linn County can be reimbursed for fuel and oil costs for Search and rescue aircraft use.

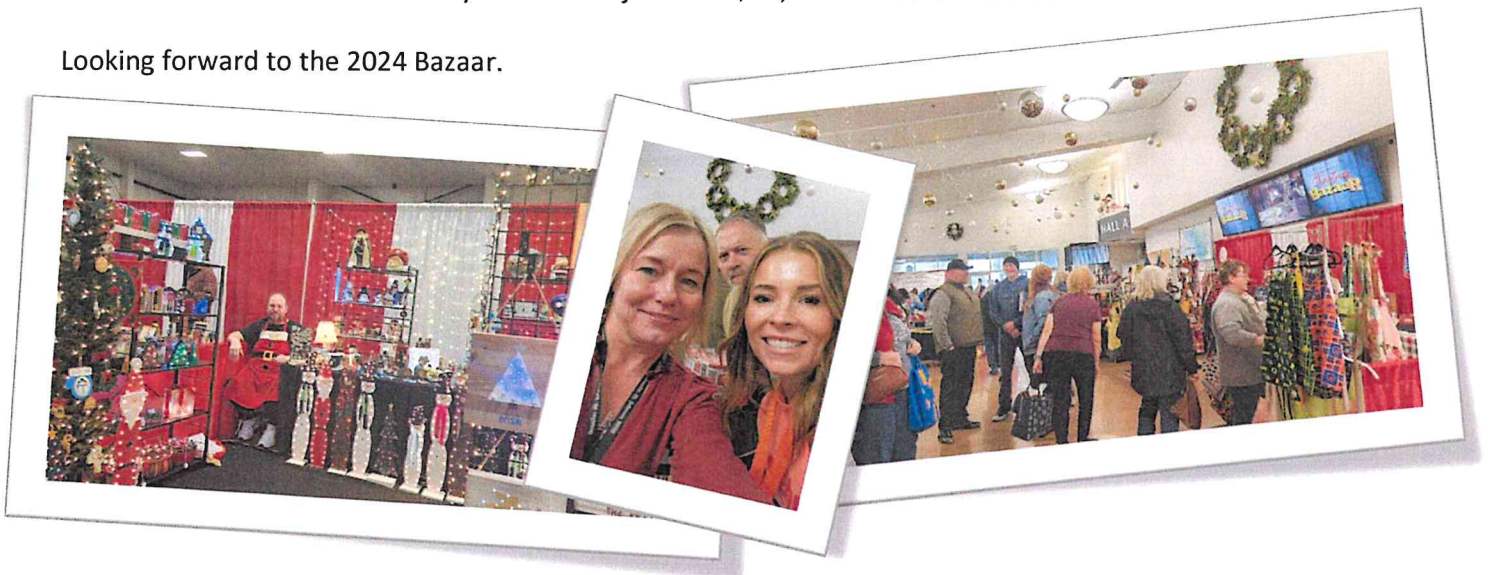

There are currently 86 youth under the Community Programs Unit serving on informal probation and the Intervention Specialist is currently serving 105 youth. 96 of those youth are from the community with no involvement with law enforcement.

Order # 2023-423 is a grant increase within the Sheriff's office for the EMPG Grant. It has been extended for this next year. They did not know about it when the budget was presented in May. This will increase what they know will be their new funding for 2023/24. For a total of \$ 70,000.

Re: Order # 2023-424

Order # 2023-424 this is a grant increase within the Juvenile Department. The grant is for Psycho/Psych/Assessments within the Juvenile Office. This is a new grant funding for this next year. For a total of \$ 14,000.
