### **Detention**

### **Probation**

The Juvenile Department received 42 referrals during the month of January 2024.

Of the 42 referrals, 7 represent dependency, 14 status and 19 criminal.

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There are currently 220 youth in the Probation Unit either on probation or pending court with 52 of those being assessed high-risk.

There are currently 84 youth under the Community Programs Unit serving on informal probation and the Intervention Specialist is currently serving 118 youth. 112 of those youth are from the community with no involvement with law enforcement.

Victim Advocate made 94 contacts.

### **Work Crew**

Tier 1 – 8 youth completed 147.50 hours of community service in 9 project days. In 2023 1 youth completed 8.25 hours of service during the same time period.

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The Road Department has the following items on the Board of Commissioners agenda for the weekly meeting on February 27, 2024. The following is a brief description of the items.

**Resolution & Order 2024-059 – Memorandum of Understanding for the Delivery of State Highway Funds**

This Resolution & Order is to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Linn County and Oregon Cascades West Council of Government to disperse funds for the state highway fund exchange surface transportation block grant projects and delegate authority to Wayne Mink, Roadmaster. The project to be funded is the Goldfish Farm Road Improvement between Hwy 20 and Bridge 328-036. The remaining amount to be dispersed under this MOU is \$1,118,600.

**Resolution & Order 2024-061 – Delegation of Authority, Purchase of Supplies Contract**

This is a Resolution & Order to approve a delegation of authority to Wayne Mink, Roadmaster for purchase of liquid asphalt emulsion fog seal for the 2024 chip seals project. This purchase contract is between Linn County and Sierra Santa Fe Corporation in the amount of \$369,113.24.
