The Road Department has the following items on the Board of Commissioners agenda for the weekly meeting on May 20, 2025. The following is a brief description of the items.

Resolution 2025-172 – Authorize Road Closure, North River Drive & Quartzville Road

This is a Resolution to authorize the closure of a portion of North River Drive and Quartzville Road for the Best in the West Triathlon Festival on Saturday, June 7 and Sunday, June 8. Closure times are as follows:

June 7 – North River Drive 7:00 am – 4:00 pm

June 8 – North River Drive 7:00 am – 2:00 pm

June 8 – Quartzville Road 8:00 am – 2:00 pm

Resolution & Order 2025-176 – Authorize Road Closures, Mill City July 4th Parade
