

ALBANY — Linn County Public Health will host COVID-19 vaccination clinics from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday this week at the Linn County Fair & Expo Center, 3700 Knox Butte Road.

Vaccinations are now open to anyone who is at least 16 years old.

Tuesday's clinic will feature 900 first doses and 1500 second doses of the Pfizer vaccine.

For second dose appointments, individuals should arrive at the same time as their first dosage on their scheduled day.

The second dose appointment date is written on the back of individual's white immunization card.

Wednesday's clinic will feature 2,000 new doses of the Moderna vaccine.

People must be at least 18 years old to receive the Moderna vaccine.
