3-day Linn County Fair opens Thursday

ALBANY — Gates open at 11 a.m. Thursday for the 2021 Linn County Fair, which runs through Saturday at the Linn County Fair & Expo Center, 3700 Knox Butte Road, Albany.

Thursday is senior and military day. All seniors (60 and older) and military (with military ID) will be admitted free.

Senior day is sponsored by Linn-Co Federal Credit Union and military day is sponsored by K2 Creative.

Daily admission is \$7 for adults, \$5 for seniors 60 or older and children 12 and under get in free thanks to Boshart Trucking. A 3-day pass for adults (13 and older) is \$14. Parking is \$5 per day or \$10 for a 3-day pass.

Parking shuttles are free and sponsored by Nutrien Ag Solutions.

Thursday only, buy a carnival wristband for \$35 and get a second wristband for \$17.50. Numerous food vendors are on site and there is entertainment all day at the always popular Family Land.
