## Linn County seeks community input on new designs for Lewis Creek Park

ALBANY — Linn County Parks and Recreation is seeking input on new design concepts recently released for an updated Lewis Creek Park, located on Foster Reservoir.

The development of the new Lewis Creek Park Master Plan is a unique opportunity for park visitors to tell the county what site amenities and upgrades would make their experiences at Lewis Creek Park more fun, accessible, and safe.

As part of the Lewis Creek Park Master Plan process, Linn County Parks and Recreation conducted the first round of public outreach to gather community perspectives about Lewis Creek Park in the winter of 2020. This outreach included focus groups with the Sweet Home Chamber of Commerce, Linn County Parks Advisory Commission, and Sweet Home Youth Advisory Council; stakeholder inter-

views with organizations that host events at Lewis Creek Park; and an online community survey distributed to Linn County residents through social media, newsletters, and other community organizations.

This outreach process helped form the development of two new park concepts that aim to improve restroom and parking infrastructure, enable universal ac-

cess to water recreation, and incorporate additional site amenities such as a food truck plaza, playground, and terraced seating along the water.

Park visitors can directly shape the final concept and master plan by viewing the concepts and voting on the proposed options in a short county survey, located at linnparks.com/parks/lewis-creek/.

The survey is available online until July 19, 2021, and those who take the survey can be entered to win their choice of an overnight stay at one of the county's camping facilities or a Lewis Creek County Park season pass.

Opportunities to review the concepts in person will also be available through tabling events in the park on select Saturdays in early July.

Following the open survey period, the county will finalize a preferred design concept and collect additional feedback before the Master Plan is finalized later in 2021.
