Linn County plans Farmers Market vaccination clinics

ALBANY — The Linn County Public Health Department will hold COVID-19 vaccination clinics at the Albany Farmers Market from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, May 15, and Saturday, May 22.

The market is at 4th and Ellsworth in downtown Albany.

Walk-ins are welcome and no registrations are required.

Individuals must be at least 18 years old and parental consent is required for all minors.

Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines will be administered.

Clinics will also be held this week at the Linn County Fair & Expo Center from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday. Walk-ins are welcome.

The Pfizer vaccine will be administered on Wednesday and the Moderna vaccine will be administered on Thursday.

Vaccinations are available for anyone 16 years of age or older. Must be 18 to receive the Moderna vaccine.
