# 515.010 Inventory searches of vehicles authorized

- (A) A vehicle that has been impounded, seized as evidence in a criminal investigation, or seized for forfeiture, by a law enforcement officer shall be inventoried for condition and property contents.
- (B) The inventory shall include, but is not limited to, the contents of all closed containers and compartments within the vehicle. The condition and contents shall be described on a property receipt.
- (C) All impounded or seized items of personal property contained in the vehicle that are not a part of the vehicle and that appear to have a value of more that \$100 shall be removed from the vehicle and stored in an evidence locker.
