Signs of Early Psychosis

Early psychosis and psychosis risk symptoms look different from the acute symptoms of psychosis, Look for the following changes:

- Drop in grades or job performance
- New trouble with focus and concentrating
- Suspiciousness, paranoid ideas or uneasiness with others
- Withdrawing socially
- Thoughts and feelings that are new, or out of character
- Decline in personal hygiene
- Difficulty telling reality from fantasy
- Confused speech or trouble communicating

EASA Eligibility

Criteria

Ages 14-25

AND

Significant decline in functioning within the past year (academic/employment, social, emotional, self-care

AND

Screened into program using Structured Interview for Psychosis Risk Syndromes (SIPS)

OR

Has experienced a 1st episode of psychosis within the last 12 months

AND

DOES NOT meet criteria for substance or medication-induced psychosis or psychosis due to another medical condition

IQ is above 70
