## **AVAILABLE POSITION**

Community Prevention Worker – Communicable Disease Worker Public Health Department (Classification 766) SEIU Represented Full Time (37.5 hours/week) position ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

We are looking for a Community Health Worker candidate who can perform a variety of community outreach, resource linkages, contact tracing, interviews, and health education duties. This position will focus on providing engagement and support services, particularly to individuals have tested positive or been in contact with people who have contracted communicable diseases, including around drug use and sexual health. This position will focus on meeting individuals "where they are at" and providing non-judgmental, non-coercive services and resources to individuals.

- Make referrals to community services and programs, including assisting in Oregon Health Plan enrollment and linking to public health programs.
- Support clients with medication compliance under the guidance of health officer and RN.
- Provide support to facilities experiencing outbreaks of disease.
- Attend required team, community, and regional meetings.
- Collect data and report activities.
- Implement community education, communication, and outreach strategies.
- Interview clients and educate about risk reduction and resources available to reduce risk of communicable diseases.
- General knowledge of communicable diseases (including sexually transmitted infections, respiratory diseases is preferred.
- May assist clients in both individual and group settings.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

High school diploma or GED is required. Ability to work with minimal supervision. Two years' experience working with communicable diseases is preferred or prior training and experience with high risk populations to reduce risk and prevent communicable diseases which demonstrates the ability to perform the work described. Spanish speaking preferred. Must have valid Oregon Driver's License.
