ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB: Supervise the Maintenance and Repair of County Roads in the Albany Maintenance District and Supervision of Assigned Personnel:

- Plan, assign and oversee personnel and equipment in maintenance tasks
- o Ensure efficient use of time and materials
- Use computer and associated road maintenance software to keep accurate records
- o Train personnel in road maintenance, construction processes and equipment operation
- Respond to emergencies, complaints, inquiries, traffic control devices, to correct problems
- o Inspect roads for safety hazards and insure the proper maintenance
- o Ability to work outside in poor weather and for long hours under emergency conditions
- o Give instructions in safety and see that Safety Rules are followed by personnel
- Interpret and apply terms and conditions of a Collective Bargaining Agreement
- Other duties as assigned
