Full-time position working in the Linn County Road Department

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB: Perform the following duties:

- Service automobiles, trucks, tractors and other construction equipment with fuel, oil, grease, water, coolant, hydraulic fluid, transmission fluid, and air.
- Replace filters, brakes, lights, tires, and other component parts.
- Perform other routine maintenance procedures for vehicles and equipment.
- Keep detailed records of service.
- Operate computers generally and to find parts, service procedures, and etc.
- Assist mechanics occasionally as assigned.
- Ability to perform manual work in all weather conditions
- Ability to stand, sit, kneel, bend, walk, crawl, reach and manipulate with arms, hands, and fingers. Will lift up to ninety (90) pounds without assistance.
- Display a constructive, team-supportive attitude; and build positive working relationships.

- Possession of a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), Class A, with endorsements for manual transmission, air brakes, and tanker; with an acceptable Driving Record
- Graduation from high school or GED certificate and a minimum of one (1) year experience in servicing and maintaining automotive and construction equipment
