2023 Linn County Lamb and Wool Fair Conditions:

1. Adequate safety precautions shall be taken to protect the motoring public from hazards.
2. Pavement Markings and Signs – See attached sheet!
3. All Flaggers shall possess State of Oregon flagger certification. Flaggers shall use appropriate advanced warning signs (only if directing motor vehicle traffic).
4. Chalk paint should be the **only** paint used on the edge of the road.
5. Road closure points shall be manned at all times by volunteers that are not in event.
6. Two people shall be in charge of setting up road closure signs. Phone numbers shall be provided to the Linn County Road Department for those individuals.
7. Signs shall not be left up overnight. Signs shall be picked up every night and set back up the next day.
8. Signs will be picked-up and dropped off at the Linn County Road Department Scio Shop at 38666 Richardson Gap Rd. Organization in charge of event will be charged for any signs not returned within 7 days after the event and forfeit their deposit.

COMES NOW, Katrina Clouse, and others, representing the Linn County Lamb and Wool Fair Association (Association) and respectfully makes application (Exhibit 1) to the Board of County Commissioners for Linn County (Board) seeking the Board’s approval to close certain portions of a county road in the City of Scio for purposes of conducting an annual Lamb and Wool Fair parade and its related activities; and,

WHEREAS, The Board having now considered the request by the Association to use certain portions of County Road No. 611, in conjunction with its annual parade and related activities on May 19 - 20, 2023, and being advised by the County Roadmaster; and, now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED, That the application of the Linn County Lamb and Wool Fair Association to close certain portions of County Road No. 611 be approved subject to the following conditions:


1. That the closure of County Road No. 611, in the City of Scio, is limited to those portions of the road more particularly described in Exhibit 1 and is limited to the times and purposes stated below:




- 1 a. County Road No. 611, between NW First Avenue and NW Fourth Avenue, from 3:00 pm to
- 2 11:00 pm, May 19, 2023, for a car show and from 12:30 pm to 6:00 pm, May 20, 2023, for a
- 3 vendor fair; and
- 4 b. County Road No. 611, from SW Fourth Avenue to Scio High School, from 10:45 am to 1:00
- 5 pm, May 20, 2023, for the formation, conduct, and disbanding of the Annual Lamb and
- 6 Wool Fair Parade; and
- 7 2. That the Association seek and obtain approval from the City Council of the City of Scio and the
- 8 Oregon State Highway Department for the closures, alternate routes, and uses; and
- 9 3. That the Association be and is hereby charged with the duty of providing appropriate barricades
- 10 and traffic control personnel; and
- 11 4. That the placement of the barricades and traffic control be subject to the direction of the Linn
- 12 County Road Department; and
- 13 5. That county staff issue a permit for use of the county road(s).

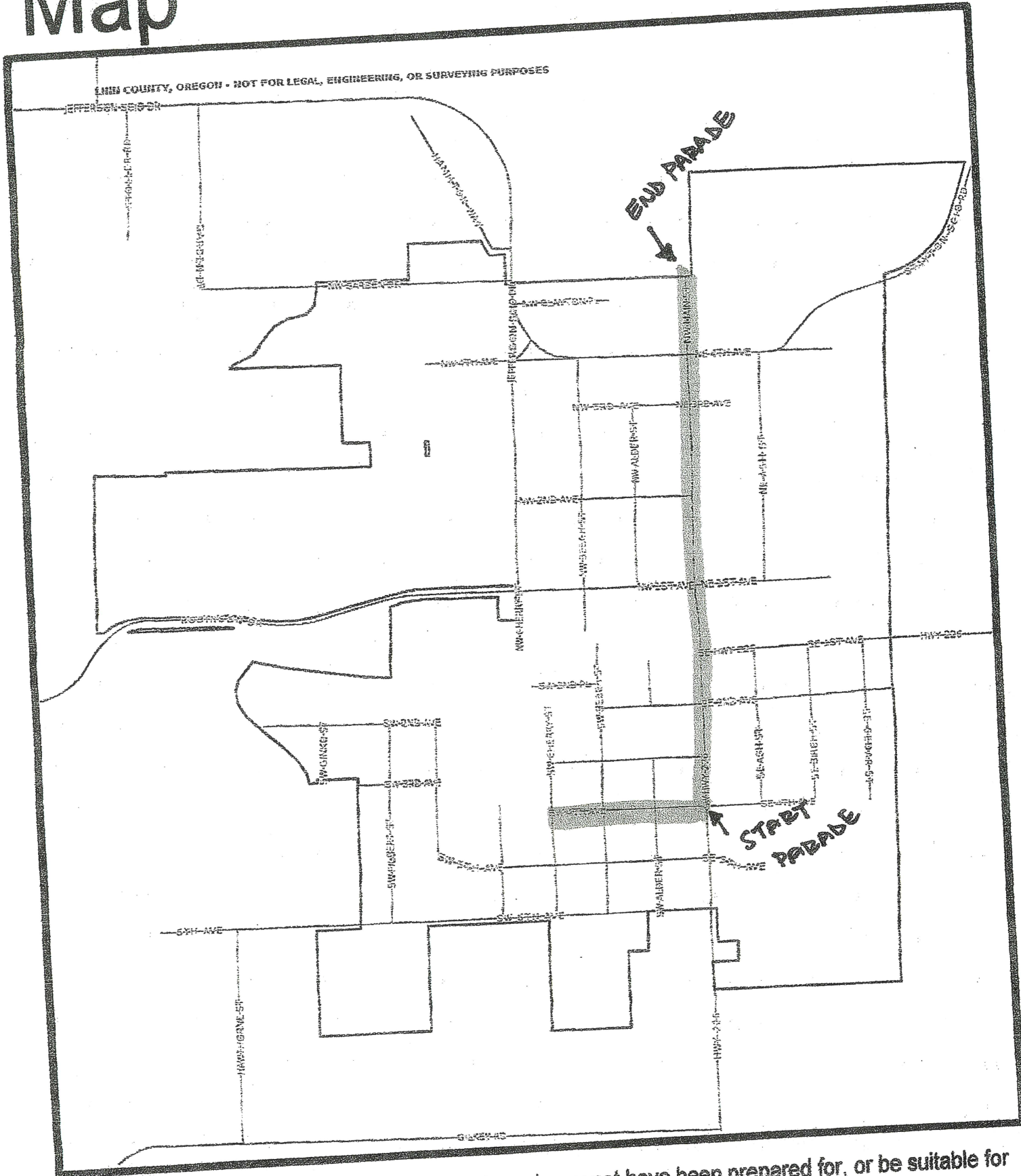
