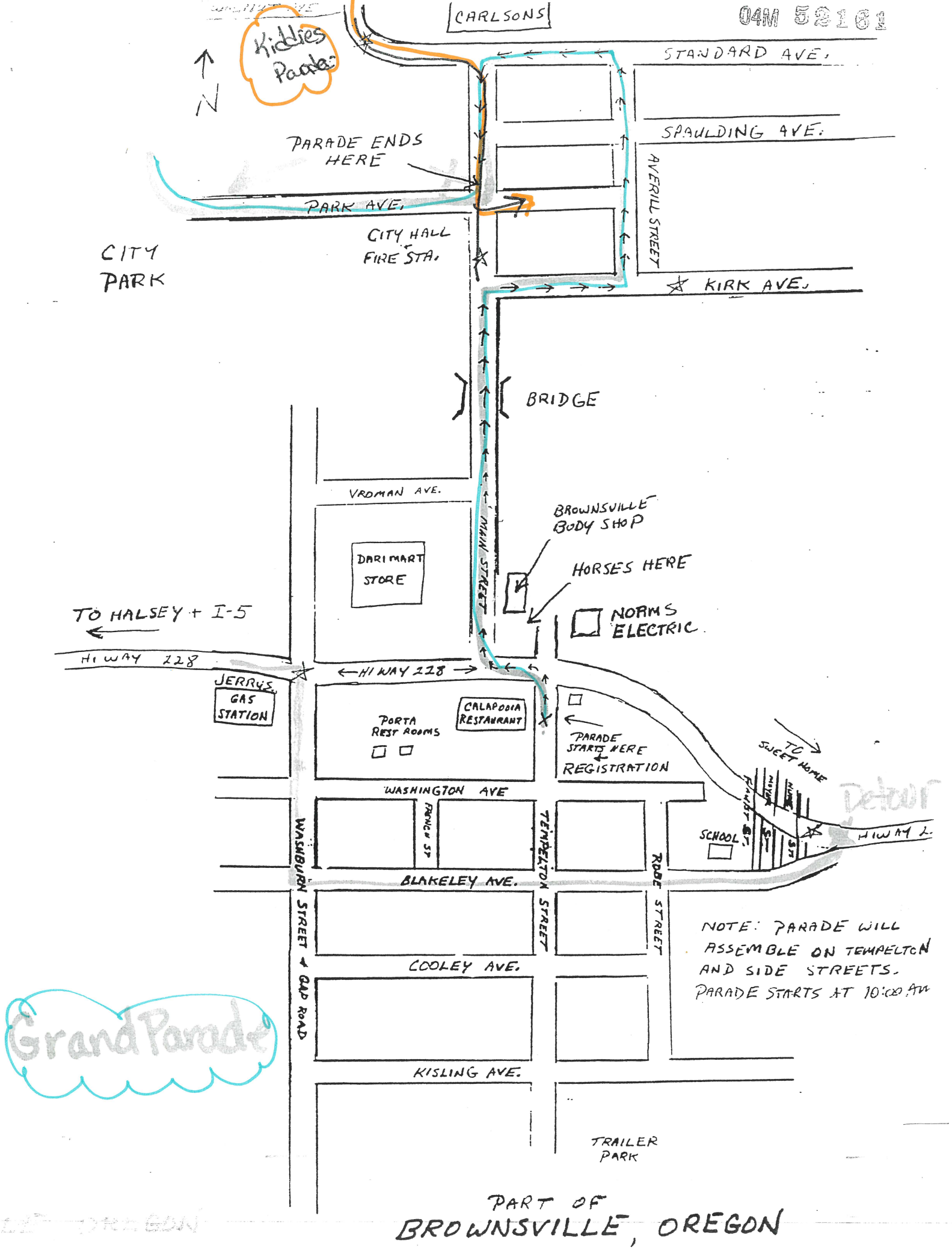

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-160
(Road Closure)

COMES NOW, The Linn County Pioneer Association (Association) and respectfully makes application (Exhibit 1) to the Board of County Commissioners for Linn County (Board) seeking the Board's approval to close certain portions of a county road in the City of Brownsville for the purpose of conducting the annual Linn County Pioneer Picnic parades; and,

WHEREAS, The Board having now considered the request by the Association to use certain portions of a County Road in the City of Brownsville, being Main Street (County Road Number 0425) in conjunction with its annual Kiddie Parade on June 20, 2025, and Grand Parade on June 21, 2025; and being advised by the County Roadmaster; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the application of the Linn County Pioneer Association to close certain portions of a county road be approved subject to the following conditions:

1. That the closure of Main Street (County Road Number 0425), in the City of Brownsville, is limited to those portions of the road more particularly described in Exhibit 1 and is limited to the times and purposes stated below:



- 1 a. From 1:00 pm to 1:30 pm, June 20, 2025, for the Kiddie Parade; and
- 2 b. From 10:00 am to 11:30 am, June 21, 2025, for the Grand Parade; and
- 3 2. That the Association seek and obtain approval from the City Council of the City of Brownsville and
- 4 the Oregon State Highway Department for the closures, alternate routes, and uses; and
- 5 3. That the Association be and is hereby charged with the duty of providing appropriate barricades and
- 6 traffic control personnel; and
- 7 4. That the placement of the barricades and traffic control be subject to the direction of the Linn
- 8 County Road Department; and
- 9 5. That county staff issue a permit for use of the county road.
