4. All Flaggers shall possess State of Oregon flagger certification. Flaggers shall use appropriate advanced warning signs (only if directing motor vehicle traffic).
5. Chalk paint should be the only paint used on the edge of the road.

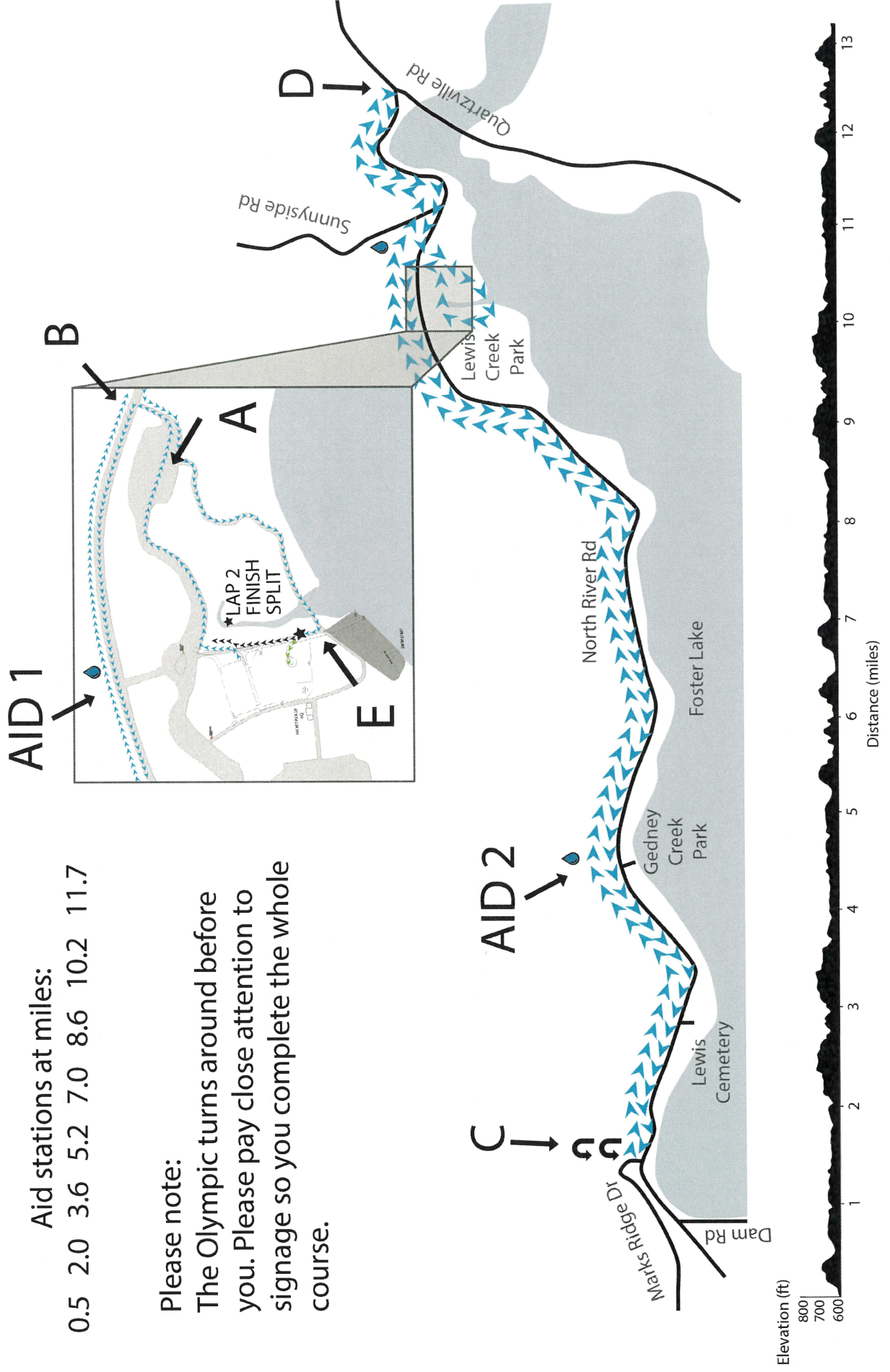

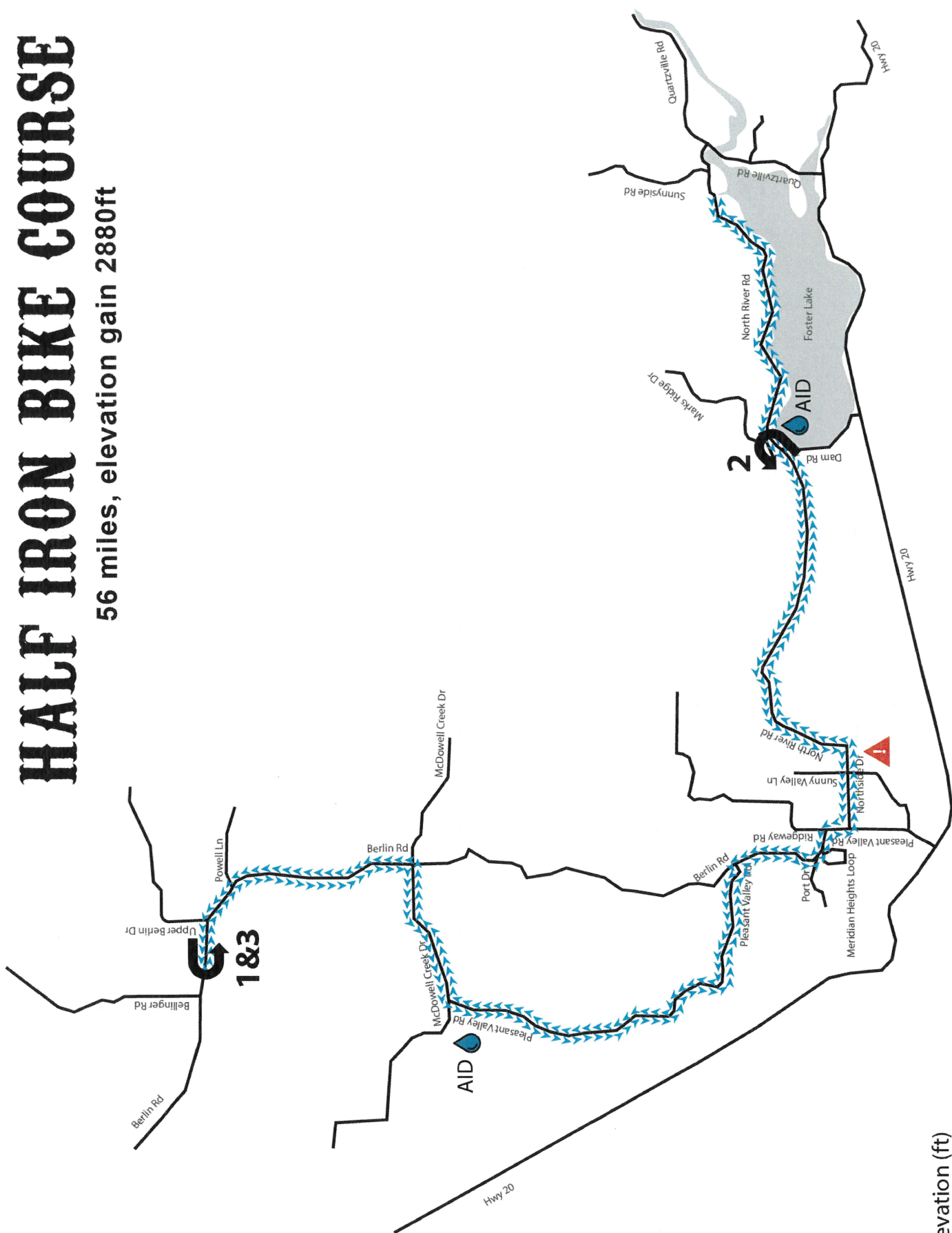

HALF IRON BIKE COURSE

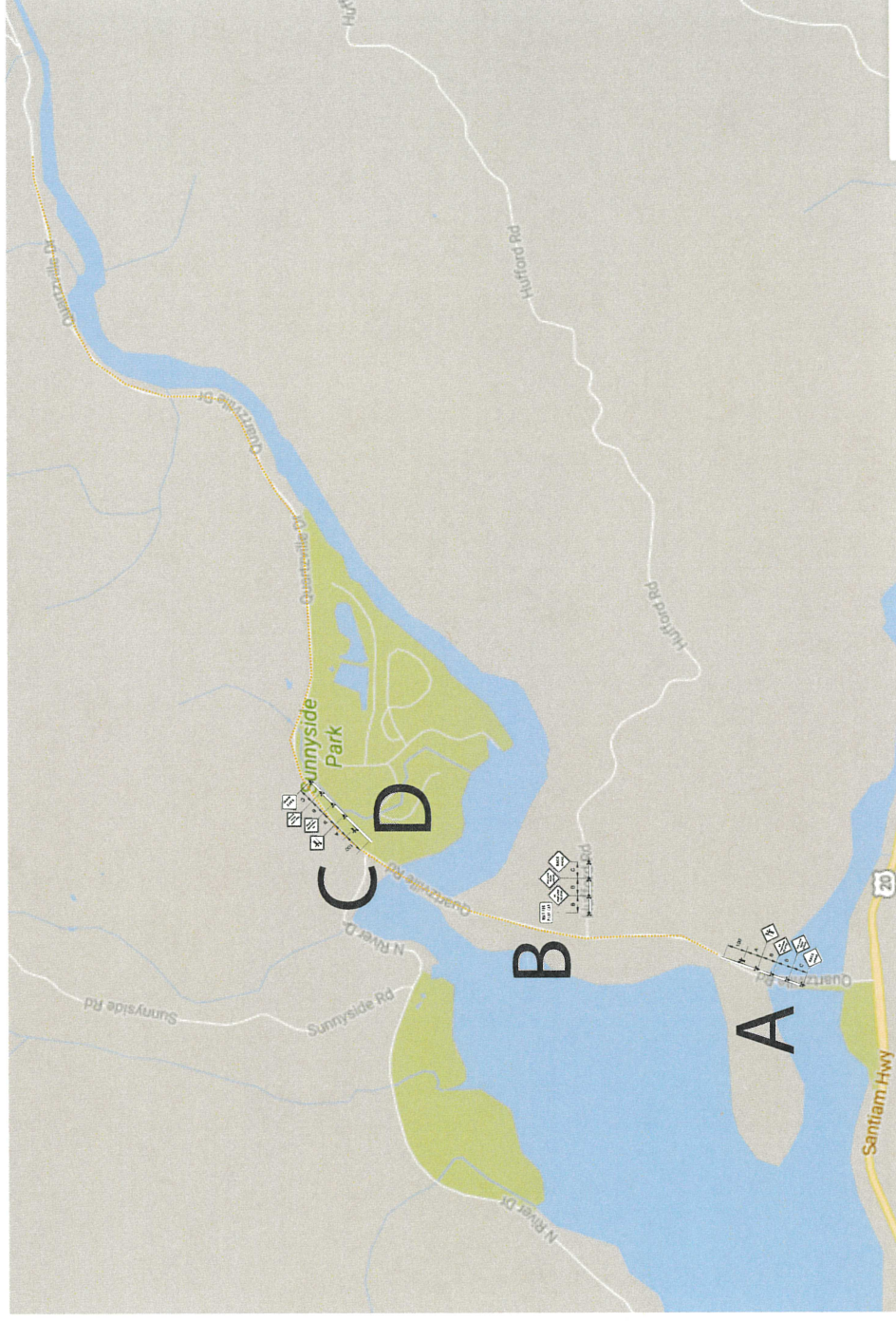
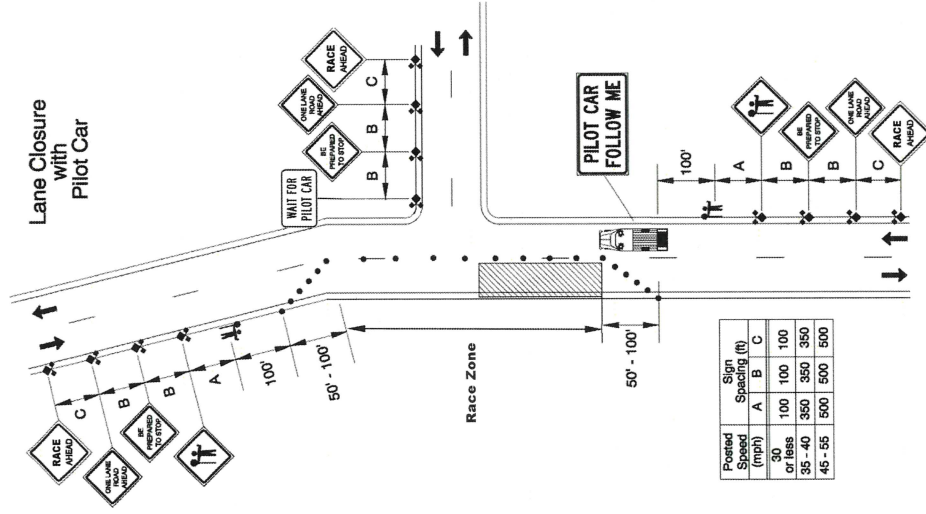

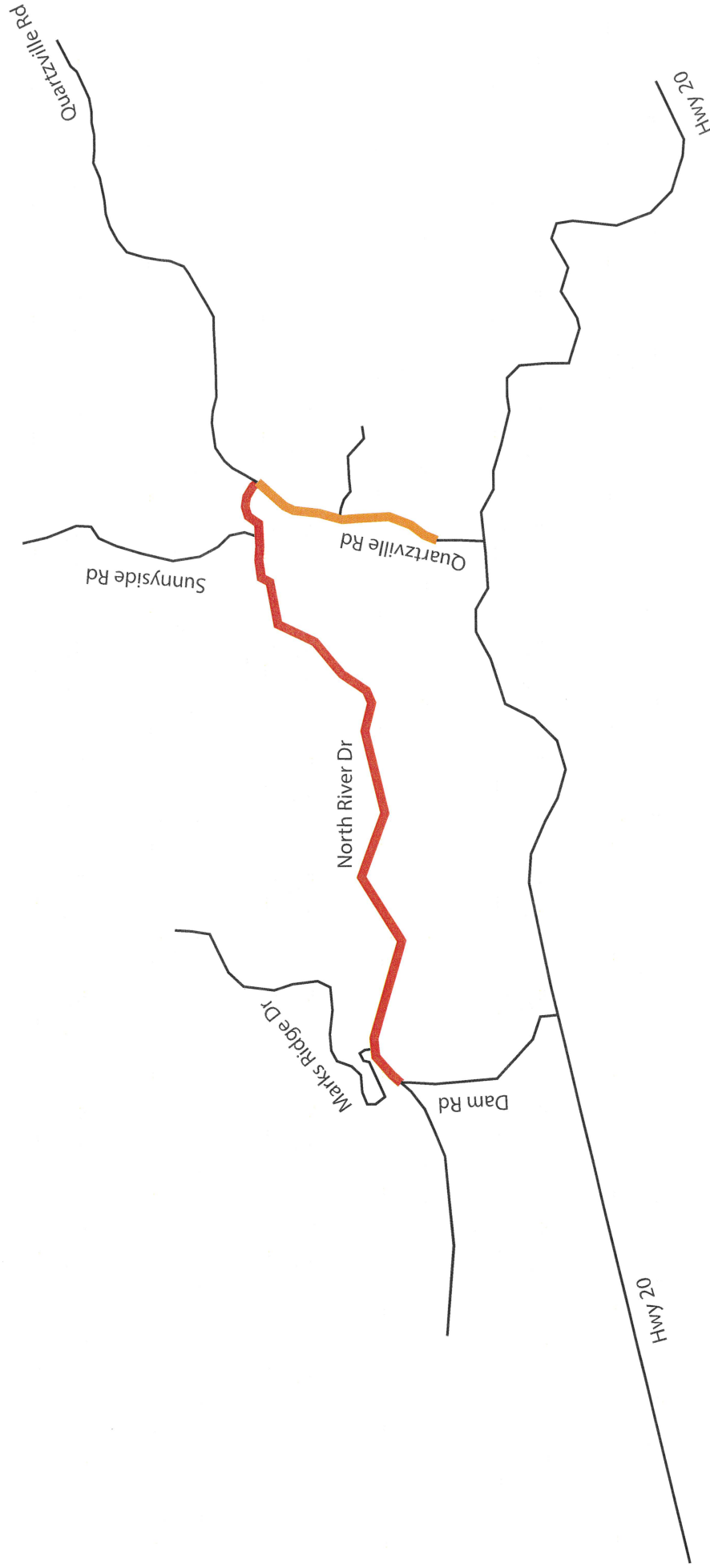


QUARTZVILLE ROAD ONE LANE CLOSURE



- A:** One lane closure begins 0.3 miles from HWY 20. The north bound lane of Quartzville road will be open, the south bound lane will be closed. 28" traffic cones with reflective bands will delineate the road on the center line the entire length of the closure. A 4 flag station including Event Ahead, One Lane Road Ahead, Be Prepared To Stop, Flagger Person will proceed the closure and will be placed according to the speed zone of 45-55mph facing north bound traffic.
- B:** Hufford Rd will be set with a 4 flag "Wait for Pilot Car" station.
- C:** North River Dr will be closed from Dam Rd to Quartzville.
- D:** Closure ends at North River Dr. A 4 flag station including Event Ahead, One Lane Road Ahead, Be Prepared To Stop, Flagger Person will proceed the closure and will be placed according to the speed zone of 45-55mph facing south bound traffic

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-172
(Road Closure)

COMES NOW, Blair Bronson, Applicant, for Best in the West Events, and respectfully makes application (Exhibit 1, attached hereto) to the Board of County Commissioners for Linn County (Board) seeking the Board's approval to close certain portions of county roads (North River Drive and Quartzville Road) in the City of Sweet Home to conduct a "Best in the West Triathlon Festival"; and

WHEREAS, The Board having now considered the request by Blair Bronson of Best in the West Events, to use certain portions of North River Drive County Road Number 0035 and Quartzville Road County Road Numbers 0932 and 0912, for a "Best in the West Triathlon Festival" on June 7 and 8, 2025, and being advised by the County Roadmaster; and, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the application of Blair Bronson, Best in the West Events, to close certain portions of county roads be approved subject to the following conditions:

1. That the closure of North River Drive is limited to the portion of the road as shown on the



- 1 attached map, (Exhibit 2, attached hereto), and is limited to the time and purpose stated
2 as follows: from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, Saturday, June 7, 2025, from 7:00 am to 2:00 pm, Sunday,
3 June 8, 2025, for a triathlon event; and
4 2. That the closure of Quartzville Road is limited to the portion of the road as shown on the attached
5 map, (Exhibit 3, attached hereto), and is limited to the time and purpose stated as follows: from
6 8:00 am to 2:00 pm, Sunday, June 8, 2025, for a triathlon event; and
7 3. That Blair Bronson, Best in the West Events, be and is hereby charged with the duty of providing
8 appropriate barricades and traffic control personnel; and
9 4. That the placement of the barricades and traffic control be subject to the direction of the
10 Linn County Road Department; and
11 5. That county staff issue a permit for use of the county road.
